At the end of the fifth year since we launched this journal, we would like to share with you our main ideas about how we intend to move on in the future. First of all we would like to dedicate ourselves to the quality of the published articles so the journal is cited in the relevant bases, whereby we would also have confirmation of quality. In doing so, we will retain our original idea of orientation towards the region of Central and South-East Europe, in that in each issue at least half the articles we publish will be from authors from that region. This does not mean at all that we are closed to work from the global environment, on the contrary, we will have sufficient room for good quality articles from the rest of the world, as we have done so far.

We remain focused on the field of organization, technology, management, law and economics in construction. We would be particularly pleased to publish the results of research, best practice, case studies, ideas for solutions for complex problems, proposals of innovations and the results of experience on important projects.

In the past year we have published a few articles commissioned from very well-known and internationally renowned authors, whom we would like to thank in particular for their support for our journal (Edmundas Kazimieras Zavadskas & Tatjana Vilutienė). In future we would like to continue this practice, so that in each issue we publish one commissioned article by a well-known author, on a topic of his/her choice, naturally within the area covered by the journal.

Using a similar approach, we have decided to publish in each issue an article from the work of young researchers or practitioners, who have not yet been affirmed, but who have dealt with important or interesting topics as part of their research or practice.

Two years ago we decided to launch a special issue each year with a guest editor. We thank them (George Hagan, Milen Baltov and Naomi Brookes & John-Paris Pantouvakis) for their major contribution to the development and confirmation of this idea, and we will continue this practice in future.

It is a great pleasure to present in this issue of the journal 8 very interesting articles, of which 4 are from the region, and the rest are from India, China, Nigeria and Saudi Arabia.

We invite you to publish your work in our journal and share with researchers and the professional public your valuable insights stemming from research or practical work.
